Upcoming exhibitions in 2013

Special exhibitions in 2013 – Highlights in the Main Hall

Essen, December 19 2013

In 2013 Museum Folkwang will be making the Main Hall the primary venue for its exhibition programme, where it will present spectacular photography and contemporary art.

Things will kick off with *Cairo. Open City – New Testimonies from an Ongoing Revolution* (2 March 2013 until 5 May 2013, PC: Thurs 28 February 2013, 11 a.m.), an experimental exhibition project exploring the on-going Egyptian Revolution from the outbreak of the Arab Spring to the present day in the media of photography and video. The show does not represent a concluded process, but rather elevates the open aspect of the political process to a formal principle.

Parallel to this exhibition, the show *Blumenfeld Studio – Colour, New York, 1941 – 1960* (2 March until 5 May 2013, PC: Thurs 28 February 2013, 11 a.m.) will open in the Main Hall. It will feature portrait and fashion photography from the Golden Age of U.S. magazines and illustrated publications.

In summer 2013 the Main Hall will once again serve as the stage for a cooperative project with the Ruhrtriennale, which is set to continue its collaboration, successfully begun in 2012, with the international art festival "Fest der Künste". A first-class exhibition of performance art awaits you. Further information to follow.

The exhibition "*Only what is not is possible* – Surface and space in contemporary painting (1 June until 28 June 2013, PC: Fri 31 May 2013) will be presenting positions in contemporary German painting in the large exhibition hall.

The exhibition *Thomas Schütte. Women* (21 September 2012 – 12 January 2014, PC: Fri 20 September 2013, 11 a.m.) will as of September 2013 bring together one of the central series by the artist, who counts among the most important sculptors of his generation. The complete *Women* series will be on show for the first time in Germany at Museum Folkwang.

Moreover, parallel exhibitions will be on show with exhibits from the graphics and photography collections and the German Poster Museum. Please see the following list for dates.
